

IUD and Implantable Birth Control

Patient Information

You have expressed an interest in having an IUD or Implantable birth control device placed at Doctors of Women. Please read the following information so you can know our process for assisting you with getting this device placed.

1. We will determine that the provider has an order on file for you to have a birth control device. Sometimes it will be necessary for you to see your provider to discuss the risks and benefits and make sure this device is the best fit for you.
2. We will contact your insurance company to get an *estimate* of what coverage you have for this device. It is important that you give us your most current insurance information, so the estimate can be more accurate.
3. You will then be contacted by our office and we will let you know what your coverage estimate is. If you decide that you still want to have a device placed, we will ask you to pay 50% of the device price up front. This can range from \$216 to \$425 depending on the device.
4. The device will then be ordered and will usually arrive at our office within one week. We will then call you to schedule your appointment for placement of the device. The best recommended time for IUD placement is during your menstrual cycle.
5. We will bill your insurance company for the Birth Control device as well as the placement of the device. Occasionally you may be asked to have an ultrasound to confirm the device is securely placed. This would also be billed to your insurance. The deposit you paid at the time of ordering the device will be applied toward *any* remaining balance on your Doctors of Women account after your insurance company has made its determination of coverage.
